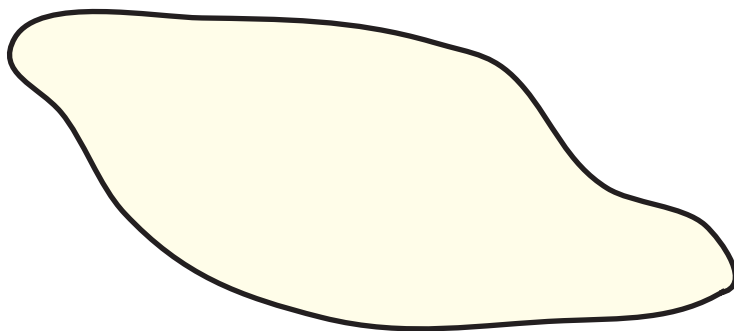
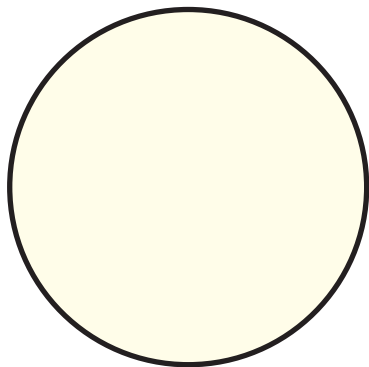


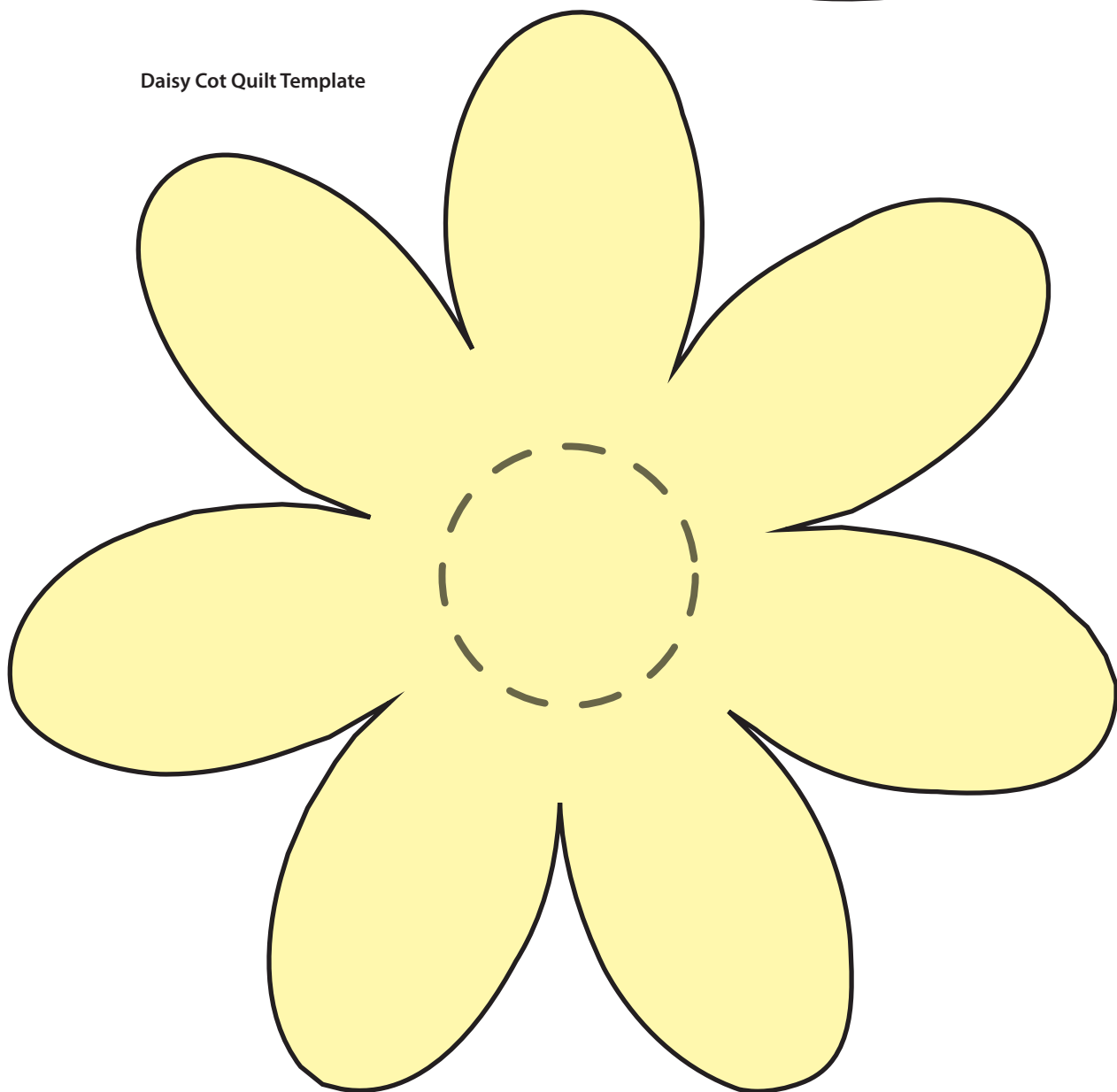

Flower Power Tote Templates

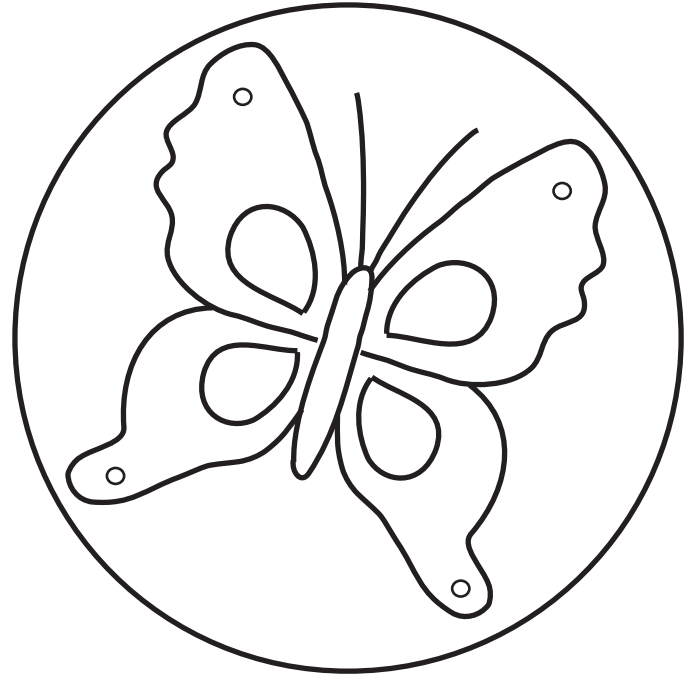
Add ¼in (6mm) seam allowance all round if using needle-turn or freezer paper appliqué.



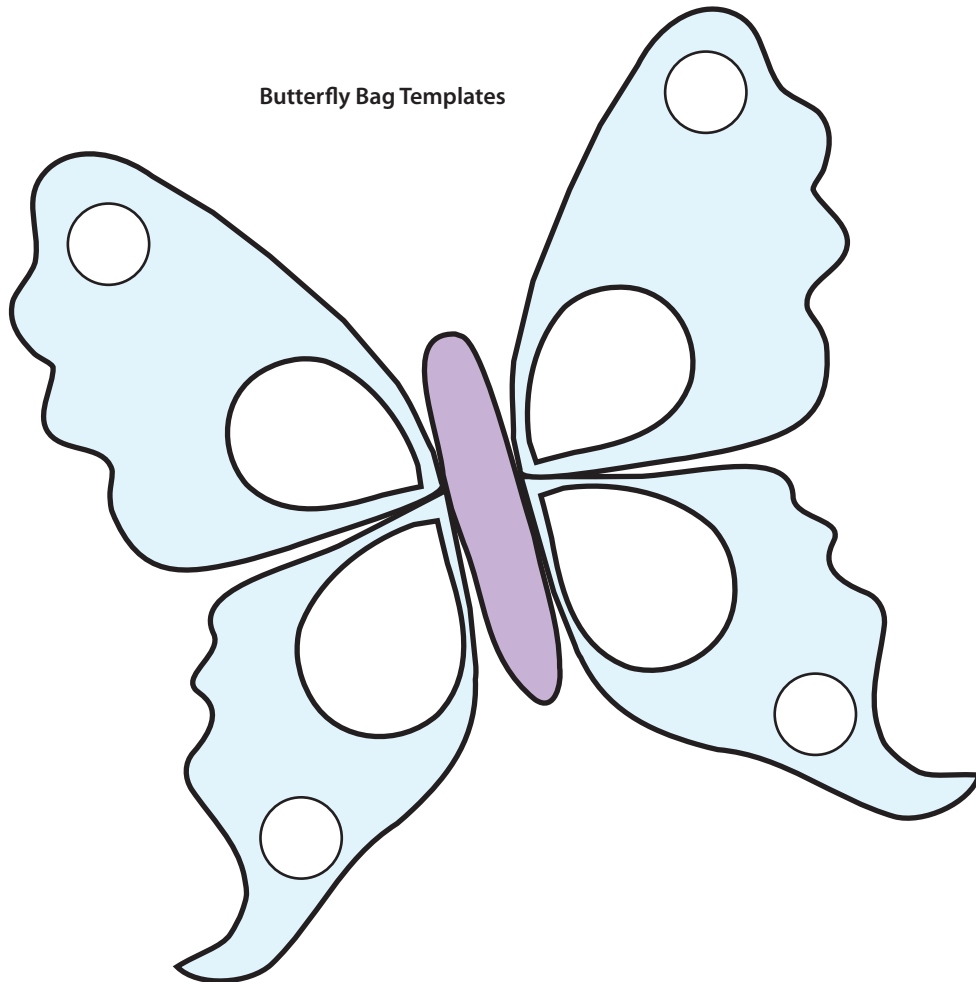
Daisy Cot Quilt Template

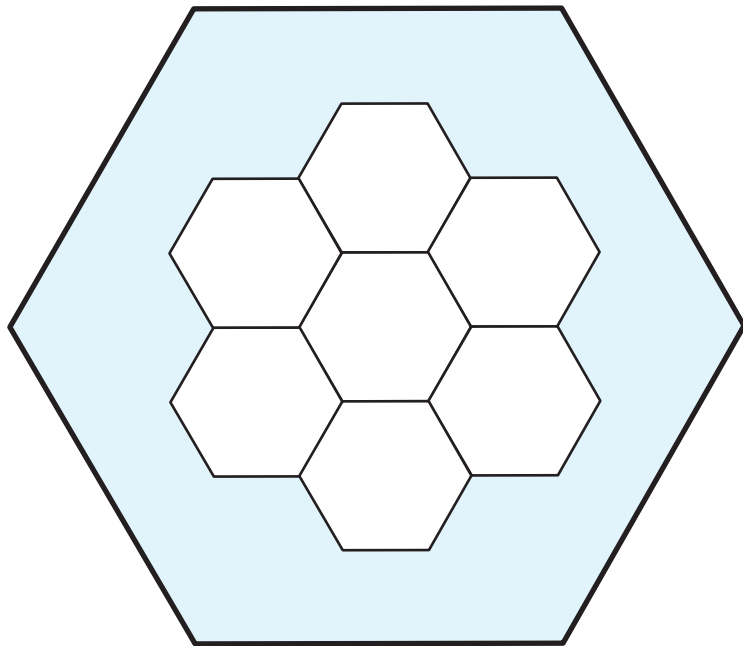


Welcome Cards Templates



Butterfly Bag Templates

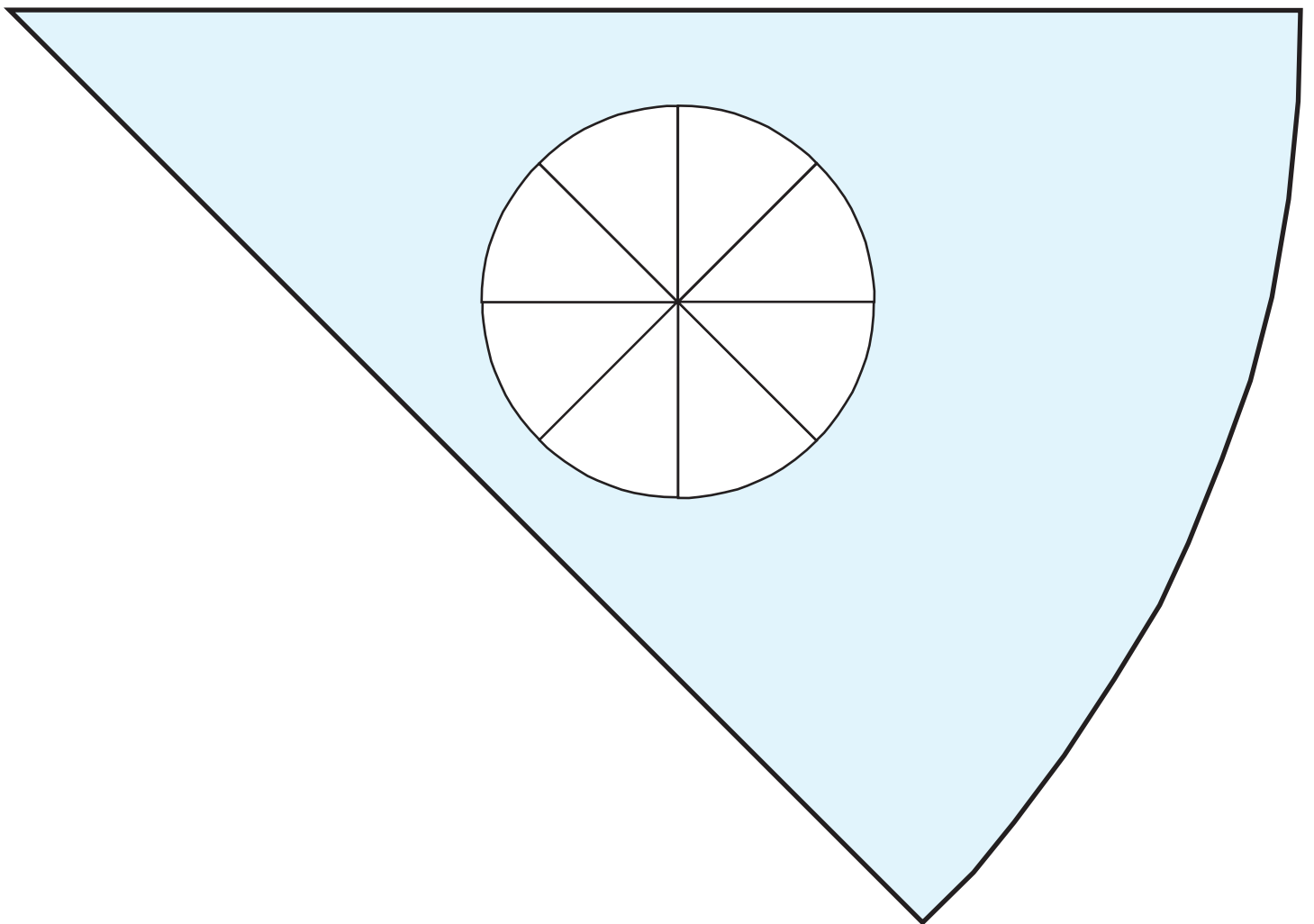




Summer Cushion Templates

The finished layouts are also shown.

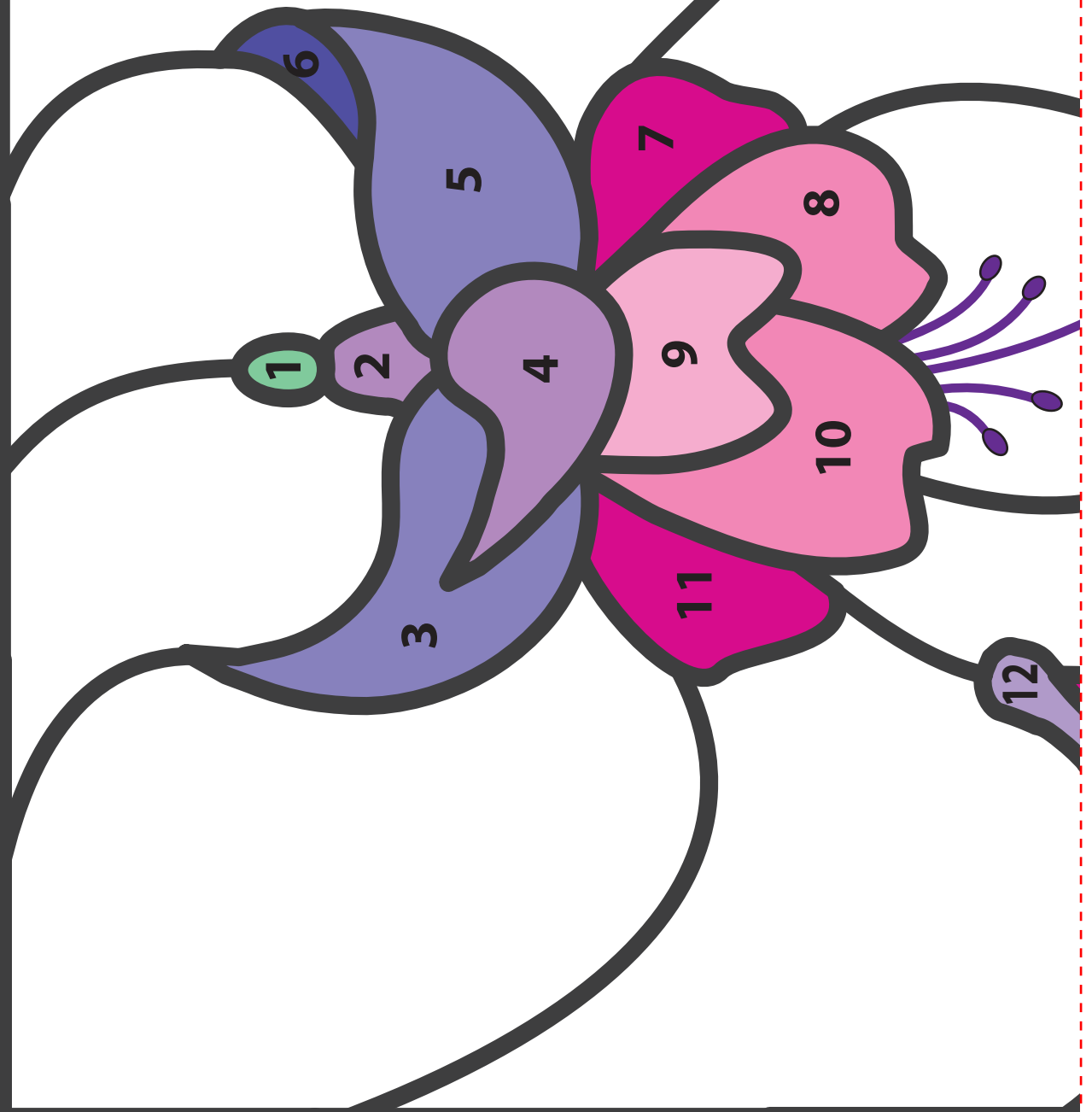


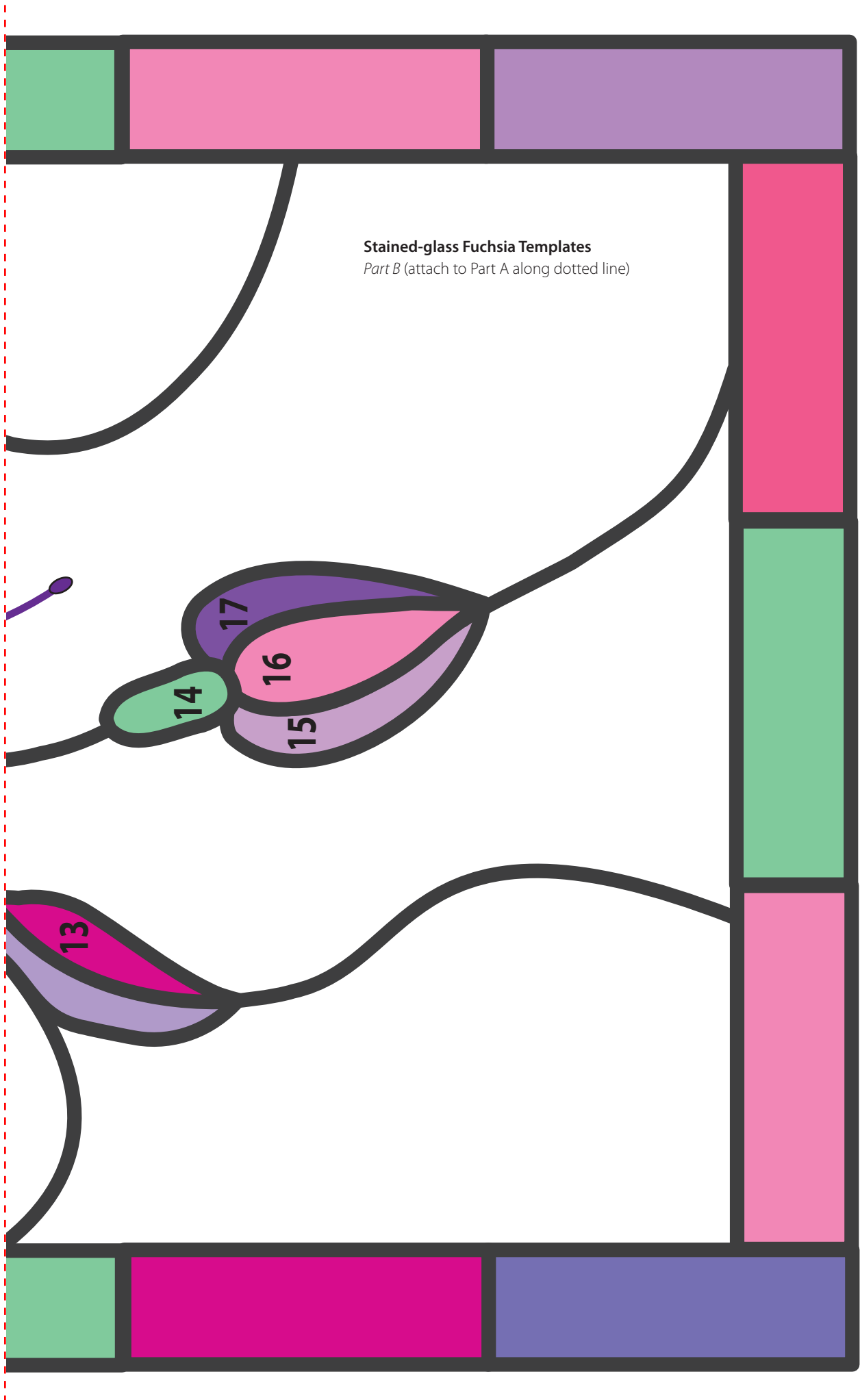
Floral Lap Quilt

Stained-glass Fuchsia Templates

Print two copies – one to cut up and use as templates for all the shapes and one as a guide for positioning the bias tape and border. Stitch the stamens with whipped backstitch or stem stitch with a seed bead at each end.

Fusing Diagram (not shown at actual size)

Fuse or sew the bias tape in place in the following order:

Mark the outer edge of the design with pins. Bias tape lines in blue must extend past this pin-marked rectangle. Edges will be covered by the border later.
