19	Breast and Chin: Row 28 is followed by Row 27, which is incorrect. Change this to 'row 29' and change the subsequent rows.
24	Grey squirrel: Left muzzle is described twice. Second muzzle should be 'right' muzzle. Should read: With yarn AB cast on 9 sts. Work short rows (see General Techniques) to create the squirrel's left muzzle: Short row 1: K3, W+T Short row 2: P3 Short row 3: K2, W+T Short row 4: P2 Short row 5: K1, W+T Short row 6: P1 Row 1: Knit Work short rows to create the squirrel's right muzzle: Short row 1: P3, W+T Short row 2: K3 Short row 3: P2, W+T Short row 4: K2 Short row 5: P1, W+T Short row 6: K1 Row 2: Purl Cut B and join C to work with yarn AC. Row 3: [Kfb, k1] four times, kfb -14sts Row 4: Purl

50	Beginning with the Nose: Should read: Row 11: P7, turn work so RS is facing you After working three or four more rows of the nose slip each set of 9 cheek sts onto safety pins.
51	Left Side of Nose: Incorrect: Row 6: Kfb, to last st, kfb - 13sts Change to: 'Kfb, k to last st, kfb - 13sts'
53	Back and Rump: Should read: Row 35 is followed by Row 34, which is incorrect. Change this to 'row 36'

<p>54</p>	<p>Belly section should read:</p> <p>BELLY</p> <p>With yarn FHI and with 3.75mm needles, with RS facing you, pick up and knit 10 sts between the two Belly Markers (see fig. 6, A to B, dotted line). Remove Belly Markers.</p> <p>Row 1 (WS): Purl</p> <p>Row 2: Cast on 40 sts, knit to end - 50sts Row 3: Cast on 40 sts, purl to end - 90sts Work short rows for left side of belly: Short row 1: K44, W+T Short row 2: P44 Short row 3: K43, W+T Short row 4: P44 Short row 5: K42, W+T Short rows 6-12: Continue as set, working shorter rows each time until... Short row 13: K38, W+T Short row 14: P38</p> <p>Row 4: Cast off 45 sts, knit to end - 45sts</p> <p>Work short rows for right side of belly: Short row 1: P44 W+T Short row 2: K44 Short row 3: P43, W+T Short row 4: K43 Short rows 5-12: Continue as set, working shorter rows each time until... Short row 13: P38, W+T Short row 14: K38</p> <p>Cast off.</p> <p>Place the left-side and right-side cast-off edges of belly together and mattress stitch to join along cast-off edges. This creates a centre seam along the length of the belly.</p> <p>JOIN BACK TO UNDERSIDE</p> <p>Working on one side at a time join the belly to the rump and back. Begin at the tail end and match the cast- on edges of the belly together with the row ends of the back and neck up to the Neck Markers easing them to fit. You may wish to pin in place and tack in place before sewing because it's a long seam. You can begin to stuff the fawn from here if you wish, so you see the shape that's forming.</p>
<p>69</p>	<p>Fox's Right Foreleg: Should read: Row 14: Cast on 10 sts for back of right foreleg, purl to end - 20sts</p>
<p>73</p>	<p>Tail: Should read: Rows 45-48 dec): Rep last 2 rows twice - 6sts Row 49: Kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb - 8sts Row 50: Purl Row 51-52: Repeat last 2 rows once - 10sts</p>
<p>78</p>	<p>Webbed feet section should read: WEBBED FEET - MAKE 2 ALIKE</p> <p>With yarns IJ and 5mm needles cast on 4 sts.</p> <p>Rows 1-5: Work 5 rows stocking stitch starting with a knit row</p> <p>Work top of foot:</p> <p>Row 6 (RS): Kfb, purl to last st, kfb - 6sts Row 7 (WS): P1, k2, m1, k2, p1 - 7sts Row 8: Kfb, p2, k1, p2, kfb - 9sts Row 9: P1, k3, p1, k3, p1 Row 10: Kfb, p3, k1, p3, kfb - 11sts Row 11: P1, k4, p1, k4, p1 Row 12: Kfb, p4, k1, p4, kfb - 13sts Row 13: P1, k5, p1, k5, p1.</p>

	<p>PM at each end of last row for Foot Fold Markers. Work bottom of foot: Row 14 (RS): Skpo, p4, k1, p4, k2tog - 11sts Row 15: P1, k4, p1, k4, p1 Row 16: Skpo, p3, k1, p3, k2tog - 9sts Row 17: P1, k3, p1, k3, p1 Row 18: Skpo, p1, k3tog, p1, k2tog - 5sts Row 19: P1, k1, P1, k1, p1 Row 20: K1, p2tog, p1, k1 - 4sts Rows 21-26: Work 6 rows stocking stitch Cast off purlwise. Fold the foot in half at the Foot Fold Markers with WS together and whip stitch all around to sandwich top and bottom together - adding a tiny amount of stuffing into the foot (not the leg) as you do. The leg will curl in on itself. Whip stitch the row ends together along the back of the leg. Optional: You could add wire to the feet and legs to try and make the duck stand.</p>
105	<p>Wolf's Right Cheek: Incorrect: Row 7: Purl 10, pick up and purl 8 sts along to wolf's right Nose Marker - 18sts (change to Row 9) Incorrect: Rows 8-13: Work 6 rows stocking stitch (change to rows 10-15 and alter subsequent rows accordingly)</p>
106	<p>Wolf's Right Cheek: First three rows on page 106 should read: Short row 8: P4 Rows 22-23: Work 2 rows stocking stitch</p>
107	<p>Chin and Throat section should read: CHIN AND THROAT With RS facing you, return to the cast-on edge at the muzzle from the beginning of the pattern. With yarn BCD and 3.75mm needles, pick up and knit 12 sts across the cast-on edge from wolf's Right Muzzle Marker to Left Muzzle Marker (see fig. 3, dotted line from A to B). Work short rows to create wolf's chin: Short row 1: P7, W+T Short row 2: K2, W+T Short row 3: P3, W+T Short row 4: K4, W+T Short row 5: P5, W+T Short row 6: K6, W+T Short row 7: P7, W+T Short row 8: K8, W+T Short row 9: Purl to end Rows 1-8: Work 8 rows stocking stitch PM at each end of last row for Throat Markers. Rows 9-14: Work 6 rows stocking stitch Cut BCD, change to 5mm needles and join yarn K. Row 15: Kfb, knit to last st, kfb - 14sts Row 16: Purl Rows 17-18: Repeat last 2 rows once - 16sts Rows 19-32: Work 14 rows stocking stitch PM at each end of last row for Fur Markers.</p>

<p>108</p>	<p>Neck: Incorrect: Row 59: Cast off 8 sts for Side Seam, purl to end - 29sts Row 61: Cast on 6 sts for Side Seam, knit to end - 35sts Row 62: Cast on 6 sts for Side Seam, purl to end - 41sts Rows 63-72: Work 10 rows stocking stitch</p> <p>Should read Row 60: Cast on 6 sts for Side Seam, knit to end - 35sts Row 61: Cast on 6 sts for Side Seam, purl to end - 41sts Rows 62-71: Work 10 rows stocking stitch</p> <p>So subsequent rows move back by one row</p> <p>Row 72: Cast on 10 sts for wolf's left hind leg... etc</p>

<p>117</p>	<p>Badger's left cheek: Incorrect: Short row 4: K6 Row 4: Purl Cut CDE and join yarn AB.</p> <p>Change 'row 4' to 'Short row 5'</p>
